CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD FEBRUARY 2016 & PREPARED 22.01.16

1. Correspondence has been received from Andrew Upton, a Parish Councillor at Stanhoe, inviting Wells Town Council to join a Federation of Parish Councils. Mr Upton believes such a federation would have a bigger voice when campaigning about issues that impact on the parishes and the wider community.
2. A request has been received from the Wells Street Party group to use the Buttlands for an event to celebrate Her Majesty the Queen's 90th Birthday, on Saturday 11th June 2016.
3. North Norfolk Parish and Town Council Tourism Overview and Management Forum will be taking place at 7 pm on Monday 22 February 2016, at Cromer Parish Hall, Church Street, Cromer, NR27 9HH. Parishes from North Norfolk will be sending representatives to discuss Second Homes Council Tax, Affordable Housing and Neighbourhood Plans with a view to working together to facilitate change.
4. As requested, I have met with representatives of the Methodist Hall and they would be happy for a flat screen television to be installed on the back wall of the hall. The TV would be used during Council meetings to display documents and plans. I have asked Cadamy's to provide a costing for the supply of a TV together with installation.
5. In June the Town Council's Insurance is due for renewal and it is an end of the three year tie-in with Zurich Insurance. Therefore, a representative of Came & Company, the other main supplier of Insurance to Town & Parish Councils, will be attending the office at 1030 am on Tuesday 9th February 2016, to talk about their services and prepare a quote for the Town Council's Insurance. The representative is happy to meet with any councillors that wish to attend. Quotes for renewal will also be obtained from Zurich.
