CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD JUNE 2013 & PREPARED 24.05.13

- 1) I have written to County Councillor Dr Marie Strong concerning the £3640 owed to the Town Council by the County Council for the placement of the Staithe Street bollards during the last financial year. Marie has had a commitment from the relevant department to pay the money within the month.
- 2) There will be a presentation of an overview of the Better Broadband for Norfolk Programme, what it will deliver and how the broadband infrastructure will be rolled out, at Binham Memorial Hall, 7.30 pm Thursday 13th June. Marie has asked for a good turnout from Wells. At the moment only one councillor is going. If there is anyone who would be interested in the presentation please make them aware.
- 3) With regard the litter problem on the Quay, it has been confirmed with the Harbour Master that all the wheelie bins on the quayside have been removed. The Harbour Master does not wish to be involved with anymore meetings of the working party; the litter is not the responsibility of the Harbour Commissioners. Due to the availability of those involved it has not been possible to organise a meeting of the working party before the Whitsun bank holiday weekend, however, a date has been fixed for Thursday 4th July, to consider a workable solution before the main summer season.
- 4) At the last meeting Cllr Ray Hewitt voiced his concern about the unlocked wheelie bin at the rear of the Beach Road toilets. The lock on the bin is broken. I have reported it to NNDC who have promised to replace the bin.
- 5) Two new seats and a litter bin, provided by the Skatepark Group, should have been installed at the skatepark before the next meeting of the Town Council.
- 6) I have again arranged for the Town Council's mail to be re-directed to the Community Hospital for another six months.
- 7) I am currently arranging for pest control on the allotments and the cemetery.
