## CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD MARCH 2015 & PREPARED 20.02.2015

1. The Commonwealth flag will be flown from the Town Flag Pole at the Buttlands on the 9<sup>th</sup> March as part of an organised event throughout Norfolk. The flag will be raised at 10 am and it is hoped some councillors can attend.
2. As directed the Clerk has written to Hopkins Homes requesting a copy of the plan of the new sewer connection on Two Furlong Hill. Hopkins Homes has responded and declined to provide a plan, stating that as the connection has been approved by Anglian Water that should be sufficient reassurance.
3. As directed the Clerk has written to Anglian Water requesting that a camera survey be carried out on the section of main sewer between Crown Lane and Church Plain. Anglian Water has responded and has asked an engineer to investigate, a survey will be done if the engineer considers it necessary.
4. Holkham estate has been contacted about the moles infesting the eastern boundary of the Recreation Field along the railway line. Permission has been given for Ray and his team to go onto Holkham's land to trap the moles.
5. The current Street Lighting contract expires in June and the process of obtaining quotes has commenced.
6. The new proprietor of the Corner House has asked if the street light fixed to the building could be moved to the corner of the building and replaced with a more attractive bracket and light. The cost of any changes would be at the expense of the property owner and the lighting contractors have been contacted for advice.
