Proposals

- I. Improve the attraction of the Buttlands as a public space by re-profiling and re-turfing the edges.
- 2. Improve Old Staithe Walk by re-surfacing the existing track and providing a dog bin to create a better and more attractive route to the Town Center.
- 3. To erect heritage fingerposts directing the public to the shops, facilities and attractions of the town.
- 4. To consider the implementation of time limited parking on the Buttlands car park.

It was decided that permission would be sort from the whole council to implement proposals I & 2 as soon as possible. Proposal 3 could be implemented over the winter ready for next year's season. Considering advice received from the highways authority it will be necessary to consult publically on proposal 4 before taking the idea forward.

Old Staithe Walk

Following the consideration of two suggested specifications it was decided to use a crushed asphalt road surface; additional quotations will be required. Is the council happy for the working party to make the final decision in consultation with the chairman, allowing work to be commenced during the summer.

Buttlands Verges

A quotation has been obtained from Norse (£8750) who is the council's ground maintenance contractor; the work could be completed when the bonfire circle is done. Does the council want additional quotations to be obtained?

Heritage Fingerposts

Before taking the proposal forward it is necessary to agree where the posts will be placed and the facilities and attractions listed on the fingerposts. Attached is a discussion document with some suggestions. Would Councillor's please consider the Plan and offer feedback as soon as possible.
