## CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD DECEMBER 2015 & PREPARED 27.11.2015

1. The AONB is conducting five yearly elections of Community Representatives and have asked that town and parish councils be informed. Candidates should live in or close to the AONB, have a good knowledge and passion for the area and be already active within their community. The closing date for applications is Friday 15th January 2016.
2. Community Action Norfolk has invited councillors to join them for a discussion about economic development in Norfolk's rural communities. The meeting is at the Wells Maltings, Friday 11th December from 4-6pm. It is a public meeting and all are welcome. 3. The 'safety and conditions of use' sign at the skate park has been damaged and needs replacing. There are specific skate park funds available or the sign can be replaced from the general budget.

Having considered all the options and discussed the issue with Councillor Dew, I would suggest that the best option for the new Town Council Noticeboard is to mount it on the wall of Councillor Dew's shop premises rather than a free standing noticeboard on the pebbled area at the entrance to Bolts Close. The only suitable place on the pebbled area would be immediately outside the shop windows, whereas mounted on the wall opposite the telephone box it would be readily accessible without causing an obstructing. The wall mounted option is also considerably less expensive.
