CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD JULY 2015 & PREPARED 26.06.2015

1. Regardless of sending a second request, no reply has yet been received from NNDC Planning, concerning the gateway cut into the wall of the property on Freeman Street, giving unauthorised access onto the playing field.
2. A complaint has been received that the east end railway cutting is again overgrown; both the Highways Authority and County Councillor Dr Strong have been informed.
3. The Fire & Rescue Services are recruiting a community volunteer in Wells; a copy of the specification is available on the Town Council's website.
4. Notification has been received that UK Power Networks will be removing the overhead cables in Freeman Street and burying them under the road. These are cables that supply Brigg Square and after consulting with Councillor Hewitt I have raised concerns about exposed cables and connections being visible on listed buildings; I have been assured by contractors that cables will be discreetly fixed.
5. NCC is once again running their Partnership Scheme where 50% match funding is available for road safety/road improvement schemes.
6. A letter has been sent to Anglian Water requesting a representative meet with the council to discuss the odour coming from the sewage treatment plant.
