CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD JUNE 2015 & PREPARED 22.05.2015

1. I have been approached by Jean Terrington on behalf of the St Nicholas Church PCC. The PCC are considering creating a number of small wildflower reserves in both the church yard and Polka Cemetery. I have met with Jean and a representative from Norfolk Wildlife Trust who has identified six small areas that would be suitable. The PCC will decide if they want to go ahead at a meeting on 21st May and I have asked Norse to hold back with the next cut until the matter is resolved. If the PCC do decide to take the idea forward I will help Jean mark the areas and then arrange for Norse to continue with the ground maintenance. The selected areas will then be left uncut until the wildflowers have finished in July, when cutting will resume.
2. Following concerns about the state of the Town Cemetery on Market Lane, I met on site with the contractor on site and discussed the problem. It has been agreed that the grass will be sprayed to kill all the weeds, which will hopefully improve the situation, particularly in the SW corner.
3. There is a requirement to annually review the Town Council's financial orders which I have done. I recommend that the orders are fully up to date and there is no requirement for any amendment or change.
