1. I have received notice from our insurers that solicitors acting on behalf of the person who put there foot in the bollard hole on Staithe Street are still pursuing a claim.
2. E – On have increased their electricity costs for street lighting. I have negotiated a reduced rate by entering into a one year contract but there is still a significant annual increase of about 20% or £883
3. Concerns have been voiced about the width of the B1105, Two Furlong Hill, following the installation of a new footpath by Hopkins Homes. I have asked the area Highways engineer and County Councillor Dr Strong to investigate.
4. A letter of complaint has been received about the cemetery regarding the Alexander in the south west corner and mole hills. I have spoken with the contractors who will continue spraying the Alexander and pest control is ongoing. Unfortunately it is difficult to stop the moles and Alexandre encroaching from the neighbouring land.
