CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD OCTOBER 2015 & PREPARED 25.09.2015

1. With the end of the car park operation the council has 10 road barriers that are now surplus to requirement. With limited storage it may be prudent to dispose of them; the carnival committee have expressed an interest.
2. A report has been received that a section of the Rope Walk Wall, a schedule two listed structure behind the west side of the Buttlands, has been demolished. I have written to NNDC Planning asking them to investigate.
3. It was previously decided that other town and parish councils in North Norfolk should be approached to consider coming together to form a tourism forum so that common problems could be discussed and solutions considered. I have now had expressions of interest from a number councils and it is time to consider the next step.
4. An application has now been submitted to Norfolk County Council for part funding under the Parish Partnership Scheme to build the proposed new section of footpath at the west end of Mill Road, as agreed at the September council meeting. The total cost will be about £15,000, of which the County Council will fund half. However, the funding will not be available until the 2016/2017 financial year so the scheme has been included in the Town Council's budget proposals for the same financial period.
5. A report has been received of Japanese Knotweed growing at the East End of Wells. The relevant landowners have been informed and the District Council has been involved.
6. There was an incident on the car park while staffed by the charity volunteers where it is claimed a car was damaged. It is alleged that the car was hit by one of the entrance gates and dented. I have spoken with the claimant and asked them to provide me with the full details. The matter will then be referred to our insurers.
