Theft x 3

There are individuals who are intent on stealing it and they circulate intent upon this very crime, so we would ask people to be vigilant. In one case, it was a reel of copper cable that attracted the thieves, understandably perhaps, Copper prices are at an all time high. The third theft was a handbag was taken from a public house
And enquiries continue in regard to this matter.

Deception's x 1

In a relatively unusual case, a deception occurred whereby a quantity of notes were offered for exchange and in the transaction (which was declined), a lesser amount was returned. This crime is Rare but not unique and the best advice must be if the situation looks odd then it probably is.

Malicious Wounding x 1 and Assaults x 2

2 were in a domestic setting and the Malicious Wounding relate to an incident at a public House.

Unlicensed Musical Event x 1

There has been a problem of late, with Raves across the county and we have not escaped but on this occasion we seized all the equipment and the law allows us to not return the equipment nor will we. Raves, are not simply parties they are a magnet for illegality particularly alcohol and drugs and we would ask for continued vigilance and if you think you hear music emanating from whence it shouldn't then report it.
