CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD JULY 2016 & PREPARED 24.06.16

1. Norfolk County Council is proposing to sell off the part of the old railway cutting at the east end of Wells which belongs to them. Marketing and disposal has yet to be progressed, Marie Strong will keep the Council informed.
2. At 7.30 am on Friday 1st July 2016, the British Legion will be holding a short remembrance service at the War Memorial to commemorate the start of the battle of the Somme. During the service there will be three short blasts on a whistle to signify when the troops went over the top. Councillors and members of the public are invited to attend.
3. County Highways have now decided that the proposed signage scheme for the new car park on Freeman Street will not include any signs at the junction of Two Furlong Hill and Mill Road to direct traffic to the Stearmans Yard car park via Park Road. All traffic will be directed to enter the town's car parks via Freeman Street
4. A letter has been received from a resident expressing concerns about the ground maintenance at the Polka Cemetery and the Churchyard. The complainant is also concerned about a problem with rabbits at the Polka Cemetery. The letter will be brought to the attention of the newly formed working party who are considering future ground maintenance requirements.
5. It is hoped a date can be agreed at the next town council meeting for the first meeting of the ground maintenance working party, I would ask councillors to consider suitable dates.
