- Tugboat Yard
- Eliza Adams Lifeboat Disaster Memorial Site, Beach Road
- Old railway cuttings to East and West
- Green space Northfield Crescent
- Primary and High School Playing Fields
- Neilson Close Playground
- The land to the west of the Beach Road between the Football Field and Pinewoods Caravan Site.
- Grazing Land Northfield Crescent
- The field immediately behind the sea wall to the east of the Harbour Boat Storage
