

Please find below Data for the December Wells Town Council meeting. -

During November we received 3 complaints of thefts, 1 burglary other than dwelling, 1 hate incident and also 1 threat to damage property.

I have also checked the calls received in the past month with regards to Anti-Social Behaviour in the town, and the breakdown is below –

1 x Environmental ASB - is defined as an incident which impacts on the wider environment, e.g public spaces, buildings but is not aimed at specific individuals or groups

0 x Personal ASB - is defined as an incident which is targeted at a specific individual or group

5 x Nuisance ASB - is defined as an incident which targets the wider community but is not aimed at a specific individual or group

2 of these calls were in relation to large groups of youths congregating on the park and at the Quay

Our SNAP meeting took place on Thursday and the new priorities for the following 3 months are –

Anti-social behaviour on Beach Road Playing Field Wells

Seasonal thefts of Turkeys from establishments breeding birds for Christmas. The Poaching of Deer on land at night, Hare coursing during the day and associated firearms offences

Church related thefts
