### Battery Recycling

Household batteries can be recycled by placing them in a bag on top of your Black or Green bin lid. Lithium, Zinc, Nickel Cadmium are all recycled into their component parts. The component parts can be re-used in new batteries and electronics, in the steel industry and in paints.

Note, car batteries, damaged batteries and laptop/mobile phone/tablets batteries **cannot** be recycled using this service.
