# ANNUAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES

Annual Town Meeting held on 24 April 2017 at 1900 at The Methodist Room

Chairman: Councillor Allen Frary

- 1) Traffic Congestion  
Councillor Ray Hewitt expressed his concerns about cars causing a large tailback along Freeman Street towards the Holkham Road while waiting to access the new car park.
- 2) Police Public Engagement Meeting  
A Police public engagement meeting is to be held at Wells Police Station at 6.30 pm Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2017, residents with concerns should attend.
- 3) Advertising boards and flyposting  
Concerns were raised about the proliferation of advertising signs along the edge of the highway and fly posting. Councillor Ray Hewitt asked that it be discussed at a future Town Council meeting.
- 4) Neighbourhood Plan  
A resident asked that consideration be given to Wells having a Neighbourhood Plan. A member of the Wells Coastal Communities Team explained the team was preparing a destination management plan for Wells.
- 5) 20 mph limit Burnt Street & Church Street  
Concerns were expressed that the speed limit was being ignored. The Town Clerk explained it was hoped that the new SAM 2 activated speed warning sign would soon be available for use at both locations.
- 6) Litter thrown from cars  
A resident in Warham Road is concerned about the amount of litter thrown from cars, particularly Costa Coffee cups.
