CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD APRIL 2017 & PREPARED 27.3.17

1. Both bids submitted by the Town Council for NCC parish partnership funding were successful. The successful bids were for a portable SAM 2 speed activated warning sign that can be moved to pre-determined locations in the town and dropped kerbs for northern end of Gales Road to allow better access to the pavement for mobility scooters. Both projects will now be completed during the 2017/2018 financial year
2. The Annual Town Meeting is at 7pm Monday 24th April 2017, at the Methodist Hall. Before the meeting there may be a short Planning Committee meeting.
3. The tree surgery work required for the Market Lane Cemetery, Polka Cemetery and Churchyard has now been completed.
4. Pest control work targeting rabbits at the Market lane Cemetery has now been completed.
5. It is anticipated that at the end of the current financial year there will be a possible £10,000 underspend from various budget areas. I would suggest that the money is earmarked for the various highways projects recently put forward by the council, including the cost of any relevant traffic orders and improved parking enforcement.
