

Report on Beach Road Toilets Joint Working Group

The group met last on September 28th at which meeting the results of the survey were discussed together with the resolution of the Town Council setting out the terms of its view as to the appropriate form of development for the Beach Road site. As a result of the meeting it was agreed that the proposals from the town be referred the NNDC's consultants so that they might produce a revised set of proposals. In order to give time for the preparation of these proposals, the October meeting of the group was cancelled and the group was to meet on November 30th. This meeting was postponed owing to the unavailability of Cllr. Oliver to two dates in December: 1st and 7th. These were subsequently cancelled by NNDC due to the unavailability of Cllrs. Oliver and Fitzpatrick and Mr. Blatch the Corporate Director. I was promised more dates to be supplied by today. I also asked that we could be given advance sight of the new proposals which, I assumed, would be in the hands of NNDC before November 30th.

For the record it appears that of the four sites identified by Gleeds, NNDC's consultants, two, that at Cadogan Road, Cromer and that at Highfields Road, Fakenham have been abandoned for development.

I hope to bring to the meeting a list of alternative dates for the next meeting of the group together with the proposals from Gleeds. I am assured that they will be with me by midday on Monday.
