CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD DECEMBER 2018 & PREPARED 26.10.2018

1. The Town Council has been successful in obtaining a grant from the Sheringham Shoal Community Fund towards upgrading the Town's street lighting. It is hoped the work will be completed as soon as possible.
2. The Council has been informed by Norfolk County Council Highways that trees on the Polka Cemetery, adjacent the road, must be cut back to prevent them obstructing the highway. A local contractor has been engaged to complete the work as soon as possible.
3. As requested at the last Town Council meeting, Katherine Kitson, Barclays Community Director for Norfolk and Suffolk, was invited to the next council meeting; unfortunately she is not able to attend. The invitation has been extended to the following meeting but no confirmation has been received. There has also been communication with Barclays ATM department. Barclays are prepared to fund and maintain an ATM in the town if suitable premises can be found at a peppercorn rent.
4. The Town Sign has now been refurbished by the craftsman that originally made it.
5. The council has previously agreed to maintain the defibrillator outside the Police Station. It is now in need of a new battery and electrodes, approximately £300. I have discussed this with the custodian, using funds he has raised, together with some money from the council, it will be cheaper to replace the defibrillator with a new one rather than buy the replacement parts. I have agreed this as it equates to saving for the council.
