CLERKS' REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE MEETING TO BE HELD JUNE 2016 & PREPARED 27.05.16

1. Pat Weston has now installed the electrical cables under the Buttlands for the additional power cabinets. He is awaiting delivery of the cabinets which be installed as soon as possible. Councillor Ray Hewitt has been supervising the project on behalf of the Council.
2. On Tuesday 24th May 2016, Councillor Pauline Catton disturbed two individuals at the Cemetery using a white van who appeared to be attempting to steal large marble flower vases from some of the older graves. The suspects left when they realised they were being watched. It is not known if any vases were stolen but at least three were moved from nearby graves to a single location ready to be loaded into the van. The police were informed.
3. The litter bins on the playground were removed as agreed on 14th May. Notices were fixed to the picnic tables asking people to take their rubbish home. To date there have been no litter problems on the playground although the real test will be the Spring Bank Holiday weekend, particularly if the weather is good.
4. As agreed, from the 7th June 2016, the Town Council will be insured by Hiscox through Came & Co.
5. I have arranged an annual Playground and Skate Park inspection contract with The Play Inspection Company at a cost of £307.05, which includes one annual inspection and three operational inspections annually.
