1. Holkham Estate has refunded the £13500 the Town Council paid towards the bridge that was installed to give vehicular access from the football field to the pitch and putt.
2. Norfolk County Council is still considering the sale of the land they own along the old railway cutting at the east end of Wells; County Councillor Marie Strong has asked if the Town Council would be interested in acquiring the land through which there is a public right of way.
3. The electricity contract for the street lights is due for renewal. The current supplier, E-on, has increased the price by over 18%. If I am able to find a better deal it might be beneficial to fix a price for 3 years.
4. I have been informed by Holkham Estate that they intend to proceed with the installation of two electronic matrix signs directing cars to the new car park on Freeman Street. The signs will be situated on Stiffkey Road and Two Furlong Hill.
