Variation of Condition 2: (in accordance with approved plans and documents) of planning ref: PF/21/0774 (Two storey extension; external alterations to dwelling and detached garage including replacement windows in some altered openings, vertical timber boarding over external brickworks, replacement roof covering and removal of chimneys; detached building in garden for use as guest room) to include landscaping and swimming pool and removal of Condition 3: (materials) and Condition 5: (arboricultural report).
