Erection of replacement dwelling following demolition of existing dwelling (part retrospective).

Resolved – Objection. The Town Council have a number of concerns about this application, not least that the building, which in the Wells Conservation area, was unlawfully demolished and almost rebuilt before any planning application was submitted. It is a real concern that building regulations may not have been adhered to, considering that the building is now essentially a new build. The new walls have been built directly onto the old footings without inspection and the walls appear to have no cavity. Additionally, the new plans also exclude a large chimney which impacts adversely on the conservation area street scene. Councillors were also concerned that to date, no planning notices have been displayed in the vicinity of the property, denying local residents the opportunity of making any representation to the Town Council prior to the Council meeting.
