Due to a bit of poor planning on my part, I regret that I will not be able to attend tonight's (04/06/2018) of Wells Town Council. This is particularly unfortunate, given my interest in item 9.

My report for consideration under item 10:

- I have written to the NNDC Cabinet member for Assets requesting investment in all three NNDC public loo facilities in Wells. I have asked for immediate redecoration and a facelift to make them a bit more pleasant for their users. I have also asked for refurbishment of all three facilities – new fittings, improvements to drainage and other remedial work to get them functioning properly to mitigate some of the issues that we have experienced lately
- Planning Application PF/18/0577 (East Quay) – I have refereed this application for determination by the Development Committee because I felt that the proposed changes would introduce new unacceptable overlooking of neighbouring properties.
- Planning Application PF/18/0536 (Shepherds Hut, Waveney Close) – I have refereed this application for determination by the Development Committee because I felt that the proposed development would introduce adversely impact on neighbours' right for peaceful enjoyment of their property.
- New film campaign promotes north Norfolk as 'natural' choice for a holiday - The eleven-month campaign, North Norfolk, Naturally, running from June 2018, features ten new thirty second films focussing on the unique aspects of north Norfolk. The campaign has been funded by North Norfolk District Council and local business sponsorship.
- Alert sounded over council-tax valuation calls – There have been reports that an impersonator of someone at the Valuation Office Agency (VOA) in Brighton has been making telephone calls, promising to look into council-tax banding but asking for people's bank details at the same time. People should never hand over any financial details to callers claiming to be from reputable organisations, whether that be a government agency, a council, a utilities company or a bank.
